Bloom:	Praised for its free flowering habit, terminal racemes of elegant, soft violet drooping bell-shaped flowers, held on upright stems well above the foliage.
Bloom Period:	Good blooming period. Early summer – fall. (June – September). Deadhead to re-bloom. Re-blooming well and continuing after many other perennials have finished.
Foliage:	Strong healthy green foliage.
Habit:	Tight clumping habit. 18" x 18" at maturity.
Propagation:	Cuttings & division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Tolerates a wide variety of soil and light exposure. Best results with good soil drainage.
Additional Comments:	First year flowering, vernalization free. Common Name: Ladybells
Uses:	Garden borders, mass landscape planting.
