Characteristics

Genus & Species:Colocasia esculentaProtection Status:US Plant Patent 23,896.USDA Zone:Zone 7b-11. (5°F or -14°C).

Bloom: Foliage selection. Spath/spadix inflorescence.

Foliage: Elegant glossy dark black foliage held on dark petioles.

Habit: Tidy, clump forming habit with short runners developing close to the mother plant.

48 x 36" at maturity. Makes an ideal 6" pot 16" x12".

Propagation: TC / division. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Moist rich well drained soil in full sun to part shade. 50°F nights and 70-80°F

(or warmer) days.

Additional Comments: Excess high nitrogen or drying out can cause foliage burn.

Uses: Large containers, garden borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 8-10 weeks 1 Gallon: 12-16 weeks
