Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Dianthus hybrida</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 19,660.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Highly scented double flowers. Deep coral petals with elegant white picotte edges, carried on sturdy stems. Repeat flowering.
Bloom Period:	Early season – Fall.
Foliage:	Glaucous, blue green foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 9" x 9". (Pot Selections: 8-10")
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting, cut flower.

1 Gallon:	10-16 weeks
