Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Dianthus hybrida</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 14,437.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Masses of highly scented red single flowers with a bold maroon eye, carried on sturdy stems. Repeat flowering.
Bloom Period:	Early season – Fall.
Foliage:	Blue silver foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 7" x 7".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Vernalization beneficial, 6-8weeks at 41°F. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting, cut flower.

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-16 weeks
