Bloom:	Unique large deep violet purple blooms with a violet colored eye.
Bloom Period:	Long blooming period. Early spring– fall.
Foliage:	Small fresh green foliage.
Habit:	Compact rounded habit. 8' x 8'.
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
Additional Comments:	Tip when young to encourage strong basal branching. Ideal for 6" pots and caches. **Myrtille is the French word for Blueberry**
Uses:	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
