Key Features

- ✓ Saturated sunshine yellow buds with flame red markings.
- ✓ Glossy dark green foliage with bold red veining & stems.
- ✓ Great cascading habit.

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Lysimachia christianiae</i>
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	Estimated USDA Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).
Bloom:	Saturated sunshine yellow buds with flame red markings opening to attractive star shaped sunshine yellow blooms with red throats.
Bloom Period:	Blooming from early summer May - June.
Foliage:	Lush glossy dark green foliage with bold red veining & stems.
Habit:	Tidy trailing habit. 2-4" x 36-40".
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Happy in full sun to part shade.
Additional Comments:	Trim twice when young to encourage strong basal branching.
Uses:	Hanging containers, ground cover for borders or mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-14 weeks

Closest Variety: *L. nummularis* 'Aurea'

Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Sunburst' glossy green and red foliage **vs.** golden foliage.
- ✓ 'Sunburst' red stems **vs.** yellow stems.
- ✓ 'Sunburst' yellow flowers with red highlights **vs.** yellow flowers.
