<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Eryngium x zabelii</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Estimated USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Large intense steel-blue deeply divided flower heads with very good blue stems.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Blooming from early summer May - June.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deeply divided silver green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Sturdy upright clumping habit. 3' x 2'.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tissue Culture or Root Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Happy in moderate-poor soil in full sun.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Great for cutting.
<b>Uses:</b>	Garden borders, mass landscape planting. Great for cutting.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>10-14 weeks</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>14-16 weeks</b>

### Comparison: *E. x zabelii* ‘Big Blue’

### Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Blue Waves’ Larger flower heads **vs.** medium.
- ✓ ‘Blue Waves’ deeply divided foliage **vs.** divided foliage.
- ✓ ‘Blue Waves’ very good blue stems **vs.** green stems.
