<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Gaura lindheimeri</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Profusions of sterile clear white blooms, giving an exceptionally long flowering period.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Early summers – fall. Exceptionally long flowering period.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Stable and highly variegated green and white foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 24" x 24".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	<b>Branch sport off of Gaura Snow Fountain</b> = 'Walsnofou' PP 19,376. Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.
