Key Features

Genus & Species:	<i>Gaura lindheimeri</i>
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Profusions of sterile clear white blooms, giving an exceptionally long flowering period.
Bloom Period:	Early summers – fall. Exceptionally long flowering period.
Foliage:	Stable and highly variegated green and white foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 24" x 24".
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil. Recommended 2 trims for best branching.
Additional Comments:	Branch sport off of Gaura Snow Fountain = 'Walsnofou' PP 19,376. Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

1 Quart:	6-8 weeks
1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
