Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Passiflora hybrid</i>
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 8. (10°F or -12°C).
Bloom:	Striking contrast between soft blue petals and dark purple corona filaments. Flowers are larger and longer lasting than regular hybrids, the blooms lasts for two days. The flowers are sturdy, usually single but occasionally in pairs
Bloom Period:	Spring. Repeating summer & fall.
Foliage:	Strong clean dark green leathery foliage.
Habit:	Vigorous and strong growing.
Propagation:	Stem Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun. Trim plants in spring to shape and encourage new growth.
Additional Comments:	Improved disease resistance from the healthy leathery foliage.
Uses:	Climber and large containers.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
2 Gallon:	12-16 weeks

Closest Variety: *P.* ‘Hardy Blue’

Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Damsel’s Delight’ suitable for containers **vs.** not suitable for containers.
- ✓ ‘Damsel’s Delight’ very free flowering **vs.** reluctant to flower until large.
- ✓ ‘Damsel’s Delight’ polyploid **vs.** diploid.
