

## Geum 'Totally Tangerine'

### Key Features

- ✓ Sprays of large unique warm apricot single blooms.
- ✓ Totally sterile – giving a long flowering period.
- ✓ Robust habit.

### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Geum x hybrid</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	US Plant Patent 22,041.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Sprays of large unique warm apricot single blooms. Totally Sterile.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early summer with repeat flowering in early fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deep green cut foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tidy robust habit. Flower stems 30" x 18"
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings / Root Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun in well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Leonard Perry from the University of Vermont says: <b>"One of the top performers of all my new perennials, very robust habit. I'm very impressed!"</b>
<b>Uses:</b>	A great addition to the herbaceous border, commercial landscape planting.

<b>1 Quart:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b>
<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks</b>

### Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Totally Tangerine' warm apricot blooms **vs.** yellow blooms.
- ✓ 'Totally Tangerine' single blooms **vs.** semi-double / double blooms.
- ✓ 'Totally Tangerine' long flowering **vs.** medium flowering period.
