Key Features

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Phormium hybrid</i>
Protection Status:	US Plant Patent 24,399.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 8. (15°F or -12°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection. No bloom recorded to date.
Bloom Period:	N/A.
Foliage:	Unique narrow weeping, cream & green variegated foliage.
Habit:	Tight clumping habit. Weeping foliage give a unique distinctive look. 36" x 24" (At maturity)
Propagation:	Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in part shade. Feed regularly with high nitrogen.
Additional Comments:	Plants will exhibit best color when grown in part shade & fed weekly with a well balance fertilizer high in trace element. Remove old foliage at the base & keep in active growth. Plants will loose color with age if not tended correctly.
Uses:	Specimen containers, borders, mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	6 months
3 Gallons:	24 months

Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Blondie' unique weeping habit **vs.** semi upright habit.
- ✓ 'Blondie' fine narrow foliage **vs.** broader foliage.
- ✓ 'Blondie' good multiplication rate **vs.** average-slow.
