### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Sempervivum hybrid</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	Rights Asserted.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Foliage selection, slow to flower. Pink star shaped flowers, held in clusters, on stout fleshy stems.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Mid-late summer.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Unique icy silver rosettes flushed with lavender and pink tones. Vivid pink stems carry multiple offsets (chicks).
<b>Habit:</b>	Clumping perennial with multiple offsets (Chicks). 6-8" x 10-12".
<b>Propagation:</b>	TC & Offsets. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Well-drained soil in full sun for best color.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Common name: Hen and Chicks.
<b>Uses:</b>	Low-water Containers, Garden Border, Xeriscape landscapes.
