bicolor flowers providing months of color.
Endless color from early spring through autumn.
Small dark green foliage.
Compact rounded habit. Ideal for 4" pots, & early season containers & baskets.
Ultimately 8-12" x 8-12".
Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. License required for propagation.
Best in full sun in rich moist well-drained conditions.
Pinch when young to encourage strong basal branching. Trim after flowering to encourage good
habit a rapid re-flowering. Trim to re-flower in 3 in 4 weeks.
4" pots, & early season containers, baskets, borders & mass landscape planting.
6-8 weeks

1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
