Characteristics

Genus & Species: Buddleja hybrid (Code: BU11-11)

Protection Status:

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Full sized flowers 6-8", in indigo tones with warm orange centers. Remove spent flower and feed

to encourage re-blooming. Blooms continaully for up to 5months.

Bloom Period: Re-blooming. May to September. Foliage: Small to medium silver green leaves. Habit: Compact round shrub, 47"- x 36".

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation*. **Culture:** Full sun to partial shade, fertile well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Prune hard back to 3-4" in spring. Great for pollinator gardens. Loved by butterflies, bees and

hummingbirds. Deer resistant.

Uses: Containers, perennial borders and mass landscape planting.
