Genus & Species: Sempervivum hybrid **Protection Status: Rights Asserted.** USDA Zone: Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C). Bloom: Foliage selection, slow to flower. Pink star shaped flowers, held in clusters, on stout fleshy stems. **Bloom Time:** Mid-late summer. Cool silver green rosette. Good year round foliage color. Unlike some hybrids with best color in Foliage: winter to early spring. Habit: Large single rosette. 8" x 8". TC & Offsets. License required for propagation. **Propagation: Culture:** Well-drained soil in full sun for best color. **Additional Comments:** Drought tolerant once established. Common name: Hens and Chicks. Uses: Low-water Containers, Garden Border, Xeriscape landscapes.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	6-8 weeks
2 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
