Key Features

- ✓ Large to extra-larger rosettes. 8” x 8”.
- ✓ Year round foliage color.
- ✓ A striking 2 gallon plant with a long period of seasonal interest.



Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Sempervivum hybrid</i>
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection, slow to flower. Pink star shaped flowers, held in clusters, on stout fleshy stems.
Bloom Time:	Mid-late summer.
Foliage:	Cool silver green rosette. Good year round foliage color. Unlike some hybrids with best color in winter to early spring.
Habit:	Large single rosette. 8” x 8”.
Propagation:	TC & Offsets. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun for best color.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Common name: Hens and Chicks.
Uses:	Low-water Containers, Garden Border, Xeriscape landscapes.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	6-8 weeks
2 Gallon:	10-12 weeks

Comparison: S. ‘Commander Hay’

Key Differences:

- ✓ ‘Emerald’ silver green rosettes **vs.** red tinted rosettes.
- ✓ ‘Emerald’ large – extra-large rosettes **vs.** small-medium rosettes.
- ✓ ‘Emerald’ excellent year round color **vs.** excellent spring color.
