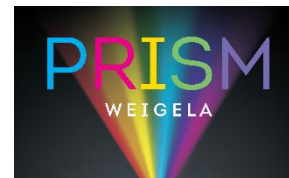


PRISM™ *Weigela* Firebird = 'WG19-109'

Bloom:	Masses of large deep pink flowers.
Bloom Period:	Full bloom May-June. Re-blooming late summer.
Foliage:	Golden yellow foliage and striking red stems.
Habit:	Compact rounded habit, 36" x 24". Responds well to trimming.
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Ideal thriller in mixed containers.
Uses:	Containers, Landscape specimen and mass landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	6-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	12-14 weeks
