<b>Bloom:</b>	Bright cherry red flowers. Continuous blooming.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Early spring – fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Elegant small dark green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact rounded habit 12" x 24". (Ultimately 24" x 36")
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood Cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, in warm garden position. Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Loves the heat. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.
