### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP 35,112
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Zone 6 (-10°F or -23°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Ruffled hot pink flowers.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Midsummer to fall. Flowering on new growth.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Striking bronze to purpl deciduous foliage. High health, good disease resistant.
<b>Habit:</b>	Unique mounding growth habit, similar to Loropetalum but much faster growing. 4' x 5' with a cut back to 4" in colder areas.
<b>Propagation:</b>	Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Thrives in moist fertile well-drained soil in full sun. Mature plants are drought tolerant.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Excellent in warmer state where they revel in long hot days and repay by flowering extraordinarily well. Excellent for pollinator gardens. Prune close to ground in early spring when growing as a shrub.
<b>Uses:</b>	Perennial border, pollinator gardens, pots & containers. Excellent for small spaces.

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>6-8 months</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>10-12 months</b>
