

Daphne 'Moon Canyon'

Key Features

- ✓ Bold variegated foliage.
- ✓ Intensely scented blooms with unique re-blooming characteristics.
- ✓ Excellent tight, rounded, compact habit 2' x 2' in 4 years.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Daphne x transatlantica

Protection Status: PPAF

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Profusions of tight heads of soft pink buds opening to pure white intensely scented blooms.

Bloom Time: Early spring followed by constant succession from summer to fall.

Foliage: Semi-evergreen, colorful variegated foliage. Bold warm yellow margin ageing to cool cream.

Habit: Excellent tight, rounded, compact habit 2' x 2' in 4 years. (Ultimately 3' x 3'). **Propagation:** Semi-ripe basal cuttings / Tissue Culture. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best in full sun in acid or alkaline soil with good drainage.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established. Test result show great heat and humidity tolerance.

Tolerant of pruning, best done after the spring flush of bloom, so very little flower is lost.

Uses: Containers, garden specimen, mass landscape planting & low informal hedge

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 12 months 2 Gallon: 24 months

Closest Variety: D. 'Summer Ice'
