| <b>Foliage:</b>             | Small dark green, ovate foliage.   |
| <b>Habit:</b>               | Compact habit. 16" x 14".  |
| <b>Propagation:</b>         | Root cuttings / Tip cuttings / Tissue culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>  |
| <b>Culture:</b>             | Well-drained soil in full sun. Trim back after summer blooming to encourage new growth & second fall blooming.   |
| <b>Additional Comments:</b> | Improved disease resistance. A robust drought resistant perennial once established.  |
| <b>Uses:</b>                | Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape.  |
