Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Leucanthemum superbum</i> (Code: L1304-13)
Protection Status:	PPAF
USDA Zone:	Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Double layer of fine fringed petals pure white in color with contrasting deep golden centers. Petal edges a pointed like ice crystals. Excellent performance in high rain fall areas.
Bloom Time:	Early-mid-summer.
Foliage:	Mid-dark green, ovate foliage.
Habit:	Tight compact habit. 24" x 18".
Propagation:	Root cuttings / Tip cuttings / Tissue culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun.
Additional Comments:	Improved disease and insect resistance. A robust drought resistant perennial once established. Wind resistant, no staking required.
Uses:	Pots & containers, garden border, modern landscape, long-lasting cut flower.
