Genus & Species:Mandevilla hybridProtection Status:US Plant Patent 21,939.USDA Zone:Zone 10. (30°F or -1°C).

Bloom: Masses of saturated dark pink trumpet shaped flowers 2-3 inches in diameter. Individual flowers

have bright honey colored throats.

Bloom Time: Spring through fall. 11 plus months of color in California.

Foliage: Evergreen, small glossy dark green foliage.

Habit: Vigorous and strong growth habit.

Propagation: Stem cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Plant in well-drained soil in full sun. Trim plants in spring to shape & encourage new growth.

Optimum growth 65°F day and night time temperature.

Additional Comments: Best selections for colder tolerance.

Uses: Patio container, pillars & hanging baskets.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 3-6 months

2 Gallon: 6-9 months (3ppp) 2ft Pillar
