Characteristics

Genus & Species: Rosa xhybrida (Code: VPRO 14-08)

Protection Status: PPAF

USDA Zone: Estimated USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Petite apple green buds opening to semi double blush pink flowers. Highly fragrant.

Bloom Period: Spring-Fall. Repeat blooming when spend flowers removed

Foliage: Petite dark green leaves. Low to thornless stems. Clean, exhibiting high disease resistance.

Habit: Tidy petite rounded habit. 24" x 24".

Propagation: Tissue Culture or Semi hardwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Highly fragrant and heavy blooming, this tidy compact rose is ideal for continued color in hanging

baskets. Perfect Mother's Day gift.

Uses: Hanging basket, Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.
