Bloom:	Petite apple green buds opening to semi double blush pink flowers. Highly fragrant.
Bloom Period:	Spring-Fall. Repeat blooming when spend flowers removed
Foliage:	Petite dark green leaves. Low to thornless stems. Clean, exhibiting high disease resistance.
Habit:	Tidy petite rounded habit. 24" x 24".
Propagation:	Tissue Culture or Semi hardwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Highly fragrant and heavy blooming, this tidy compact rose is ideal for continued color in hanging baskets. Perfect Mother's Day gift.
Uses:	Hanging basket, Containers, borders, mass landscape planting.
