

Magnolia J'ADORE™ 'Heaven Scent'

Key Features

- ✓ Masses of fragrant, rose pink flowers.
- ✓ Attractive velvet brown stems.
- ✓ Ideal 4-5ft hedge / screen.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Magnolia laevifolia (*Michelia yunanesis* Code: HYB01)

Protection Status: PP 35,506

USDA Zone: Estimated USDA Zone 8. (10°F or -12°C).

Bloom: Masses of velvet brown buds opening to highly fragrant rose pink flowers. Flowering profusley

from from late winter through spring. Flowers are formed in clusters along the entire stem, not just the terminal shoots. Repeating flowering summer through autumn in Southern California.

Bloom Period: Late winter – spring. Foliage: Small green leaves.

Habit: Compact-medium habit, with super tight internodes. 8' x 6' at maturity.

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun to partial shade, moderately fertile well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Idea as a low hedge / screen. Great for small yards and large containers.

Uses: Landscape specimen, large containers, low hedge / screen.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 6-12 months 2 Gallon: 12-18 months

Comparison: M. 'Eternal Fragrance' Key Differences:

- √ 'Heaven Scent' velvety brown stems + buds. vs. green stems and buds.
- ✓ 'Heaven Scent' rose pink flowers vs. white flower with pink edges.
- √ 'Heaven Scent' height 8ft vs. height 6ft.
