Key Features

- ✓ Heavy lateral branching giving a dense plant habit.
- ✓ Hardy to USDA Zone 5.
- ✓ Highly variegated foliage showing little to no reversion.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Gaura (Oenothera) lindheimeri

Protection Status: US Plant Patent 31,220

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Profusions of sterile clear white blooms, giving an exceptionally long flowering period.

Bloom Period: Early summers – fall. Exceptionally long flowering period. **Foliage:** Stable and highly variegated green and white foliage.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 24" x 24".

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil. Recommended 2 trims for best branching.

Additional Comments: Branch sport off of Gaura Snow Fountain = 'Walsnofou' PP19,376. Drought tolerant once

established.

Uses: Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks

Comparison: G. Snow Fountain = 'Walsnofou'

PP 19,376.

- ✓ Silver Fountain variegated foliage vs. green foliage.
- ✓ Silver Fountain masses of blooms vs. masses of blooms.
- ✓ Silver Fountain long flowering period vs. longer flowering
