

FLUTTERBY FOUNTAINS™ Gaura (Oenothera) Snow Fountain = 'Walsnofou'

Key Features

- ✓ Heavy lateral branching giving a dense plant habit.
- ✓ Hardy to USDA Zone 5.
- ✓ Exceptionally long flowering period. Great for the commercial landscape.

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Protection Status: US Plant Patent 19,376. USDA Zone:USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

Bloom: Profusions of sterile clear white blooms, giving an exceptionally long flowering period.

Bloom Period: Early summers – fall. Exceptionally long flowering period.

Foliage: Mid-dark green foliage.

Habit: Compact mounding habit 24" x 24".

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun, well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Drought tolerant once established.

Uses: Containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
