

Rosmarinus 'Tuscan Beauty'

Characteristics

Genus & Species: Rosmarinus officinalis Protection Status:Rights asserted

USDA Zone: Zone 8. (10°F or -12°C).

Bloom: Rich blue flowers.

Bloom Time: Spring and again in late summer / early fall.

Foliage: Aromatic sun kissed, light yellow foliage, more vibrant in full sun and summer. Silvery underside.

Habit: Upright habit. 4' x 3'. Ultimately 6' x 6' untrimmed. **Propagation:** Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Heat & drought tolerant once established. Sport of R. 'Tuscan Blue'. Responds well to trimming.

Flower fragrance, sweeter than R. 'Tuscan Blue' citrusy with a hint of coconut.

Uses: Herb pots & containers, garden border, hedging, modern mass landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
