Culture: Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Excellent culinary selection. Responds well to trimming. Heat & drought tolerant once established.

Uses: Herb pots & containers, garden border, hedging, modern mass landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart: 6-8 weeks 1 Gallon: 10-12 weeks
