Genus & Species:	Arabis sturii (Code: JC Select)
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Spikes of small white flowers blooms.
Bloom Period:	Spring. Light re-blooming in fall.
Foliage:	Colorful bright variegated foliage, dark green with bright pure white margins.
Habit:	Compact mat forming habit, 2” x 12”.
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade. A. sturii is great species for hot humid climates.
Additional Comments:	Easy care. Drought tolerant once established. Great in gritty areas. Exhibits good resistance to leaf spots. Common Name: Rock Cress. Remove any stems that revert to all green or all white shoots.
Uses:	Patio containers, beds, borders, landscape planting.

1 Gallon:	8-10 weeks
