USDA Zone:	Zone 7b-11. (5°F or -14°C).		
Bloom:	Foliage selection. Spath/spadix inflorescence.		
Foliage:	Unique velvet French grey foliage with contrasting apple green veins & colorful stems. This variety displays the adult foliage on the 4 th or 5 th leaf from Tissue Culture.		
Habit:	Tidy, clump forming habit. Medium grower 36 x 36" at maturity. Makes an ideal 6" pot, 16" x 12".		
Propagation:	TC / division. License required for propagation.		
Culture:	Moist rich well drained soil in full sun to part shade. 50°F nights and 70-80°F (or warmer) days.		
Additional Comments:	Excess high nitrogen or drying out can cause foliage burn. Cut back after a month in a one gallon. More lateral shoots will emerge and the finishing time will be 4 weeks later. Other benefit		
Uses:	of a cut back is that you get more white in the new, emerging leaves. Large containers, garden borders, mass landscape planting.		

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Quart:	8-10 weeks
1 Gallon:	12-16 weeks
