Characteristics

Genus & Species: Cosmos atrosanguineus

Protection Status: Rights Asserted

USDA Zone: USDA Zone 9. (20°F or -6°C).

Bloom: Cherry to wine red, chocolate scented flowers. Blooming continaully for up to 5months.

Bloom Period: Mid summer to fall.

Foliage: Fresh small to medium mid green leaves.

Habit: Clumping habit. 12-24" x 12-24" at maturity.

Propagation: Tissue Culture & softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best in full sun with moderately fertile well-drained soil.

Additional Comments: Great for pollinator gardens. Ideal for butterflies, bees and hummingbirds.

Uses: Containers, perennial borders and mass landscape planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 8-12 weeks 2 Gallon: 12-14 weeks

- ✓ Cherry Chocolate compact habit 24" vs. variable habit 24-36".
- ✓ Cherry Chocolate cherry to wine red flowers vs. chocolate colored flowers.
- ✓ Cherry Chocolate up to 5months of flowering vs. 2-3 months of flowering.
