Genus & Species:	<i>Forsythia x intermedia</i>
Protection Status:	PP 35,765
USDA Zone:	Estimated USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Golden yellow flowers cover the stems before foliage appears.
Bloom Period:	Early Season: Feb - Mar.
Foliage:	Deciduous elegant cream-white edged foliage.
Habit:	Tight rounded habit. 5' x 5'.
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best foliage color in full sun, happy in average conditions.
Additional Comments:	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching.
Uses:	Landscape specimen, borders or containers.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon:	6-12 months.
2 Gallons:	12-18 months.
