

## **Cotoneaster 'Emerald Sprite'**

## Characteristics

**Genus & Species:** Cotoneaster x suecicus (Code: OSUCOT1)

**Protection Status:** US Plant Patent 31,719

**USDA Zone:** USDA Zone 5 (-20°F or -28.9°C). Currently Testing

**Bloom:** White blooms in spring followed by colorful orange fall berries.

**Bloom Time:** Spring-summer. Flowering in year 3.

**Foliage:** Shinny small dark green foliage. Flush purple with cool fall temperatures.

**Habit:** Ultra-compact, compact spreading shrub. 1' x 3'. **Propagation:** Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.* 

**Culture:** Happy in sun to part shade in average soils.

Additional Comments: Exhibiting improved fire blight resistance. Thrifty on water use once established. Has performed

well at UC Davis trials under drought stress and disease inoculation.

**Uses:** Container specimens, garden specimen, mass landscape plantings.

## **Approximate Finishing Time**

1 Quart: 8-10 months 1 Gallon: 12-14 months

Comparison: C. 'Coral Beauty'

**Key Differences:** 

- ✓ 'Emerald Sprite' improved fire blight resistance vs. less resistant.
- ✓ 'Emerald Sprite' improved branching vs. less branching.
- ✓ 'Emerald Sprite' ultra-compact habit, 1'x 3' vs. more open habit 3' x 6'.
